2025 Membership Application (new members)

Since 30 November 2019, everyone in the UK, who flies a model weighing more than 250g is, by law, required to have an Operator ID / Flyer ID. This can be obtained by registering and passing an online test for the **Registration Competency Certificate** and paying a fee.

As a responsibly run club that is affiliated to the British Model Flying Association (BMFA), Ivel MAC will only accept membership application from people who fulfil the requirements by having:

1. **BMFA Achievement Certification,** (and therefore have an exemption for taking the test, but you will still need to pay the registration fee)

or

- 2. Already registered, and passed either the CAA or BMFA Registration Competency Certificate.
 - a. If you take the BMFA test, you will be issued with an online Certificate in PDF form, which will be needed when you join our club, after which, the BMFA will issue an Operator ID and Flyer ID.
 - b. If you take the CAA test, after successful completion you will be issued with an Operator ID and Flyer ID.

If you are new to the hobby (it is actually a registered sport) we recommend that you contact the club and discuss the situation, requirements for the test and also discuss suitable models and equipment Radio etc.

Please note:

- 1. Membership period is 1 Jan 25 31 Dec 25.
- 2. All new members are subject to a 6-month probationary period.

Furthermore, whilst this Club (Ivel MAC) has a duty to take all reasonable steps to ensure the general welfare and protection of children and vulnerable adult members, in particular during the actual act of model aircraft flying and associated preflight and post-flight procedures, the Club will not undertake the responsibilities of those acting in the role of guardians or carers.

You may not leave a child or a vulnerable adult at the flying site, that is your responsibility.

Should your child have any special medical or physical needs you are required to advise the Club Committee in writing.

Should physical contact be required during model flying for instructional or any other purpose these will be explained to you, and you will be required to record your agreement in writing defining the type and limits of contact.

Should the Club wish to use a photographic image of your child; the Club will follow the guidelines laid down by the NSPCC Child Protection in Sport Unit detailed on Page 22 of that document. In addition, your written consent will be required for the Club to do so.

This membership form must be countersigned by the parent or guardian if the applicant is under 18 years of age or by the authorised carer of a vulnerable adult, thereby signifying acceptance of the conditions of membership.

Should you wish to discuss any issue, have any concerns or have suggestions on how we may improve our policies, then please contact the-Chairman or a committee member.

Note: It is Ivel MAC club policy is that Junior members and vulnerable adults must be accompanied at the flying field by their parent, guardian or carer, at all times.
